

FUNERALS.

The Late Mr. Isaac Helliwell.

The late Mr. Isaac Helliwell, of 35 Swan-street, North Fremantle, died at the residence of his son, Mr. Leonard Helliwell, 202 Haytes-street, Subiaco, on Monday last. The deceased was born at Umballa in the East Indies, and first came to Western Australia with his parents when only four years of age. He later went to England, and, after spending about 12 years there, again came out to this State. He was for many years connected with the old Fremantle Harbour Works and the West Australian Government railway workshops when they were at North Fremantle. He won the respect and esteem of a wide circle of friends. He leaves six sons, six daughters and eighteen grandchildren to mourn their loss. His wife, the late Mrs. Rosina Helliwell, predeceased him only last year. The funeral took place yesterday afternoon, when the remains were interred in the Fremantle Cemetery, the Rev. E. H. O. Nye officiating at the graveside in the presence of many friends.

The chief mourners were Messrs. Roby, Leonard and Edgar Helliwell (sons), Messames R. Abercromby, T. Golding and A. Grant, and Miss Edith Helliwell (daughters), and Messrs. William and Ina Abercromby (grandchildren). The pall-bearers were Messrs. T. J. Briggs, R. Sutherland, C. R. Laming, J. W. Abercromby, J. R. Osborne and J. Symonds. Floral tributes were placed on the grave, and the bereaved relatives received widespread expressions of sympathy.
