

OBITUARY.

CORPORAL JOHN RILEY.

The remains of the late Corpl. John Riley were buried in the Roman Catholic Cemetery, Guildford, on September 17. Corporal Riley enlisted in the 57th Regiment of Foot, and served for nineteen years, doing duty in the East Indies and the Mediterranean, and subsequently came out from England with a detachment of enrolled pensioners, as convict guard, on the ship Sultana, arriving here on August 19, 1859. He was stationed at Fremantle, and eventually appointed in charge at Guildford, which post he held until the force was disbanded. He lived at Guildford to the time of his death, and reached the good, old age of 83. He leaves a widow and a grown-up family of three sons and five daughters.
