He requested Hartshorn being deprived of his Ticket of Leave and returned to the Convict Establishment if he persisted with his relationship with Mrs Morrissey as it reflected badly on the Enrolled Force . and administrators firmly by these
presents. Sealed with our seals this
25th day of November One thousand
Eight hundred and ninety seven.

The Condition of this obligation
is such that if the above named
Lucy Green only surviving daughter

of Bridget Sullivan late of Swan
Sheep North Fremantle deceased who
died on the third day of March
One thousand Eight hundred and
ninety seven (wherefore deceased her
husband John Sullivan late of Swan
(Swan North Fremantle Military Pensioner
deceased) And the intestate Adminis-
tration of all and singular the good
chattels and effects of the said deceased
do when lawfully called on in that
behalf make a caused to be made a
true and perfect inventory of all and
singular the good chattels and effects of
the said deceased which he or she shall
come to the hands possession and control
of her the said Administration
to the hands or possession of any
other person or persons for her
and the same so made do exhibit or
caused to be exhibited into the Supreme
Court of the said Colony at a before a day
to be named by the Master of the Supreme
Court the same good chattels credits and
effects and all other the good chattels
credits and effects of the said deceased
at the time of her death or which at
any time afterwards shall come to the
hands or possession of such Adminis-
tration to the hands or possession of any
other person or persons for her shall and
lawfully administer according to law.

And further shall make or cause
